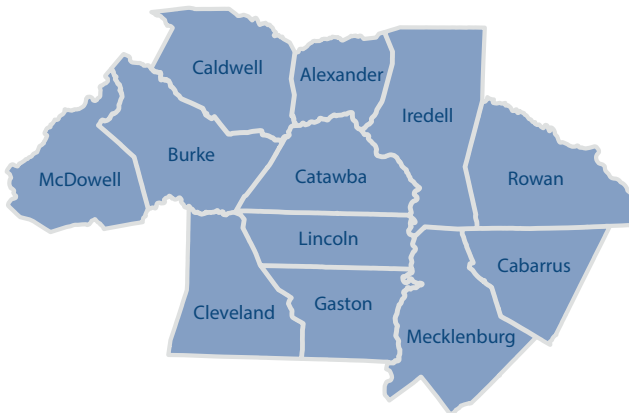




WHY SHOULD I VOLUNTEER?
